Welcome to ‘**Grace Talks**’! We are a group that teaches conversational English and are delighted that you are interested in joining us. Below you will find information about our group, what we do and what is expected of students.

Our group

We are a group of volunteers that want to provide excellent English conversational lessons to anyone that wants to learn English.

What we do

We teach conversational English at pre-intermediate level.

Classes will typically take the format of a presentation at the front of class followed by small group work based on the presentation. English speakers will be sat on each table of three to four students assisting them with their English. We use a variety of methods to teach, such as songs, games, acting, and TV and music recordings.

We plan to commence:

- a six-week pilot scheme;
- starting Tuesday January 16th at 9.30 am closing at 11 am (for refreshments and chat);
- meeting in the cafe at St John’s Wood Road Baptist Church;
- classes cost £2 per week;
- ages are 16+;
- there are no visa restrictions.

Unfortunately, for the six-week pilot scheme we are unable to offer childcare or crèche facilities.

What is expected of students

Students have to **complete our ‘Student application form’** which is available on our website at St John’s Wood Road Baptist Church and email it to ***info@sjwrb.org*** or send it to ‘Grace Talks’ – c/o St John’s Wood Road Baptist Church, 39 St John’s Wood Road, London, NW8 8QX. They will also be requested to complete an assessment on the first day so we can gauge your level of English.

Students will be expected to work hard, pay attention and be respectful to everyone in class.
